

Learning: Key Leadership Lessons


- Uncharted territory is where transformation happens




Reflect: Personal and Group Ponderings, Discussion 1

Consider the larger themes of the book:

What have you learned?

- We all need to do the work together

- Listen to others with knowledge of the environment regardless of race or gender
- We have a lot of work to do and the work looks different from what we thought it would be.
- There are things we can do right now/what is our mission
- We need to come together on a mission statement that better reflects our world now
- Mission trumps denomination




Reflect: Personal and Group Ponderings, Discussion 2

- How do we find leaders who may be not part of us yet?




Reflect: Personal and Group Ponderings, Discussion 3

- We have to learn hard lessons like how our worship might change




Reflect: Personal and Group Ponderings, Discussion 4
